

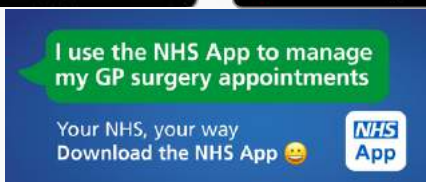

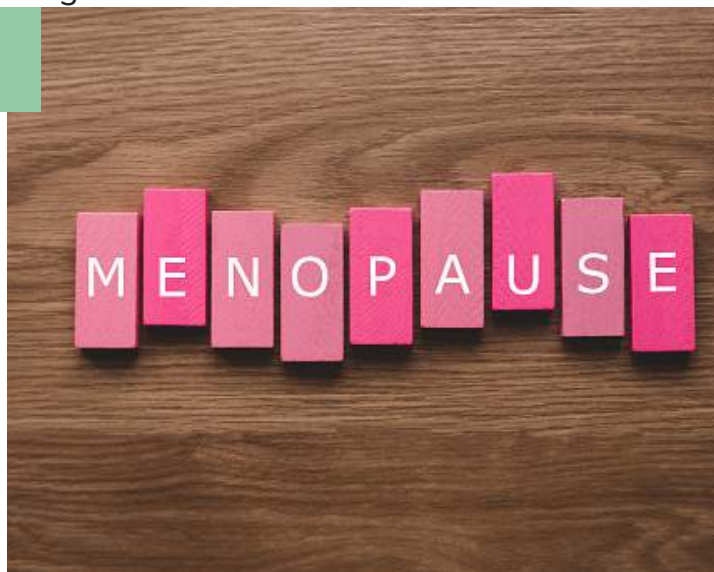
BABY IMMUNISATIONS

GROUP B STREP AWARENESS MONTH

Group B Streptococcus (Group B Strep, Strep B, Beta Strep, or GBS) is a type of bacteria which lives in the intestines, rectum and vagina of around 2-4 in every 10 women in the UK (20-40%). This is often referred to as 'carrying' or being 'colonised with' GBS. Carrying GBS is not harmful to you, but it can affect your baby around the time of birth.

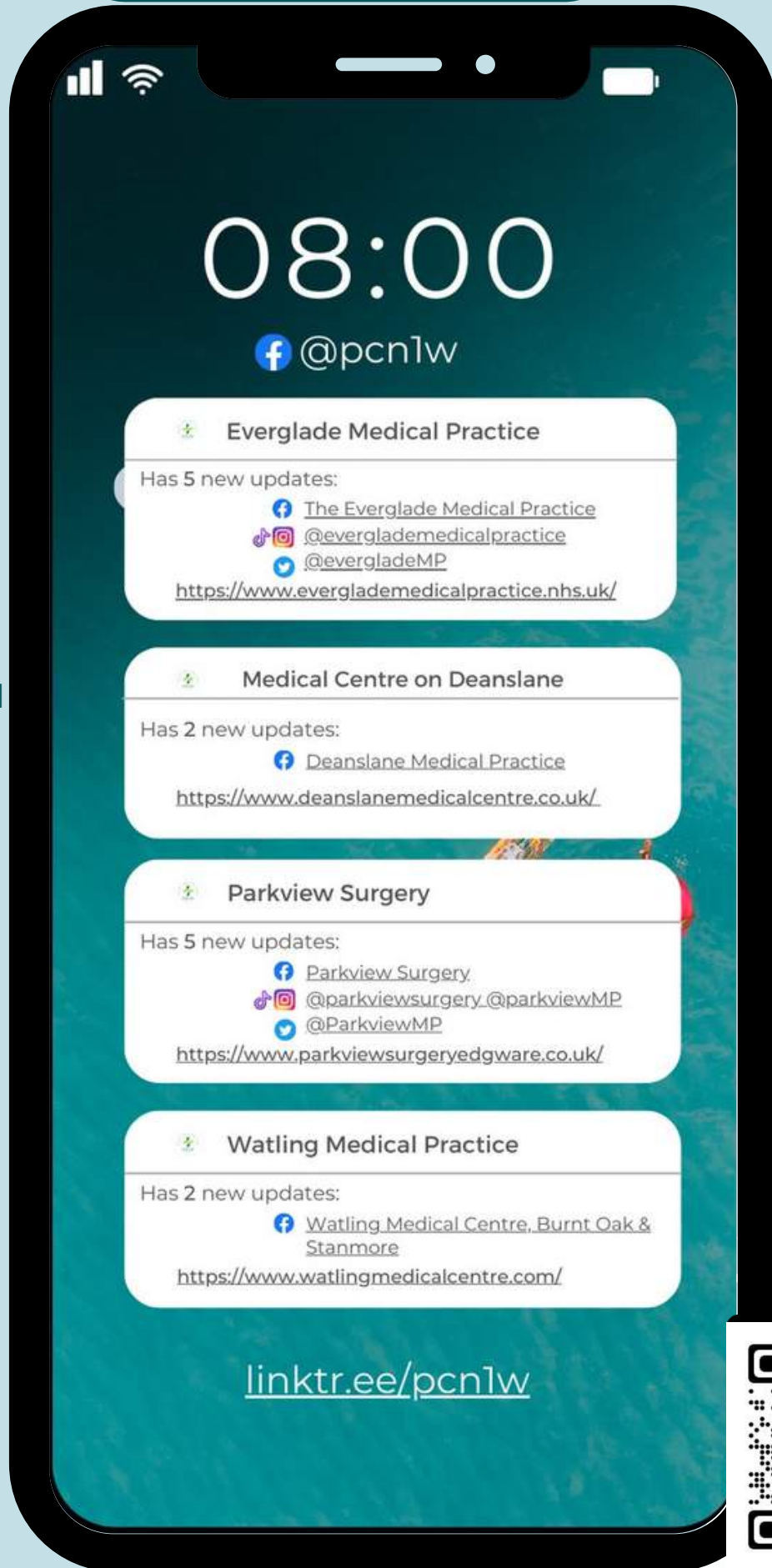
Sarcoma is a type of cancer that occurs in various locations of the body.

Signs and symptoms

- A lump which is growing, changing, or bigger than a golf ball
- Swelling, tenderness or pain in or around the bone which may come and go and may be worse at night
- Stomach pain, feeling sick, loss of appetite or feeling full after eating only a small amount of food
- Blood in either your poo or vomit

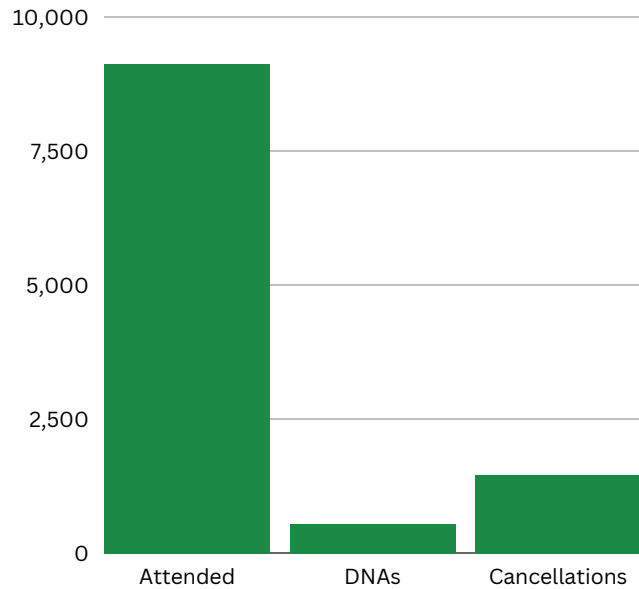
OUR FIGURES

You can currently book appointments at practices via telephone, GP Online Services, or econsult. These can be face-to-face, telephone or online consultations.

If you can **no longer attend** an appointment, you can cancel via patient access, our online web forms available on practice websites, or telephone the practice you are registered at.

From **15th May 2023 to 11th June 2023**, PCN 1W has had **12789 available appointments and 11095 booked appointments** all together; across Everglade, Deanslane, Parkview and Watling sites.
